Mac Derry noted that he has managed to persuade the local utility workers to leave us eight treated telephone polls that are about 8 feet long. There was a discussion about whether we wanted them and how we should install then. Scott and others were concerned that these might make it difficult to unload planes from trailers. He suggested that we could partially bury them by cutting a groove and dropping the polls into them to lower their profile. Shawn and Scott agreed to let the club know when they were ready to do this so they could recruit volunteers to help.

VI. Fly-in on 26th October

We discussed the scope of this fun fly and agreed to advertise it to local clubs. We would prepare food for which we would accept donations in order to raise much needed funds for the club. It was also suggested that we place a banner that would be visible from the street that would invite members of the public to come and spectate (and make donations for food). Scott, Johnny and others agreed to research where we could get the banners made. Shawn and Scott agreed to lead the planning for the fun fly.

VII. Review of the nominations and brief self-introductions by the nominees

Once the attendance/self-nomination sheet had been completed, Dave Eames asked all of the nominees to give a short introduction about themselves and why they wanted to run for office.

VIII. The club website
